Free Will

The Trinity teaches God is one being in three persons. Free will says they are three beings. They do not share an "essence." They share a "class" of life.

Dual Nature teaches Jesus Christ is fully divine and fully human. Free will says Christ is a human sacrifice.

Closed Canon teaches the Bible is complete. Free will says God still speaks and writes.

Cessationism teaches the Fivefold Ministry ended with the Early Church. Free will says God still has Apostles and Prophets.

Original Sin teaches humanity inherited a sinful nature due to Adam and Eve's disobedience. Free will says we do not inherit sin or a sinful nature.

Total Depravity teaches humanity is completely unable to choose God without divine intervention. Free will says we have the capacity to accept or reject God.

Irresistible Grace teaches those chosen by God cannot reject His grace. Free will says we can reject God's grace at any time.

Faith Alone teaches faith is the sole requirement for salvation. Free will says faith and repentance are the same event.

Unconditional Election teaches God selects individuals for salvation based solely on His will, without regard to human actions. Free will says salvation depends on us.

Eternal Security teaches once a person is saved, they cannot lose their salvation. Free will says God can abandon us.

Perseverance of the Saints teaches true believers will inevitably continue in their faith. Free will says we can abandon God.

Transcendence teaches God exists independent of the material world. Free will says Creation was an intervention in Heaven. Therefore, God is immanently involved. Therefore, all revelation is special.
